

## How to pack the box

Chartered: Building Amsterdam packs a lot into a fairly small box, not just in terms of the game play but in physical elements as well. So, please find a quick overview of how to pack the box below. The (high resolution) pictures have also been uploaded to BoardGameGeek, plus a video will follow shortly.



Packing the game is best done using:

- two of the sections (1 & 2) for the warehouses and headquarters,
- one for all the coins (3) and
- one for the cards, broken roofs and stock tokens (4).

The warehouses and headquaters are best layered into two layers: you place all the squared roofed warehouses on their side in a grid of 3x5, with the one left over squared roofed warehouse on the side next to one line. The first six headquarters and one stairroof warehouse complete this layer. Note that you can best stand three of the headquarters upright, with their facade facing the side of the box. The other three are on their sides.

The second layer is shown on the right. This layer consists of all stair-roof warehouses, where you put the stairs into the bottoms of the previous rows. Plus, make sure you slide the roof between the squared roofed warehouses on the first layer. The final three headquarters are placed on top of the three headquarters of the first layer, in opposite direction from the first layer.

Finally, you put all boards, the stock market and the rulebooks on top.
